Neck and head mobility

The ability to turn and tilt your head is important for increasing your field of vision and being able to see obstacles and traffic.

- Four real-time cameras (front, left, right, back) transmit the environment to the display in the field of view to compensate for limited head mobility.

Physical stability

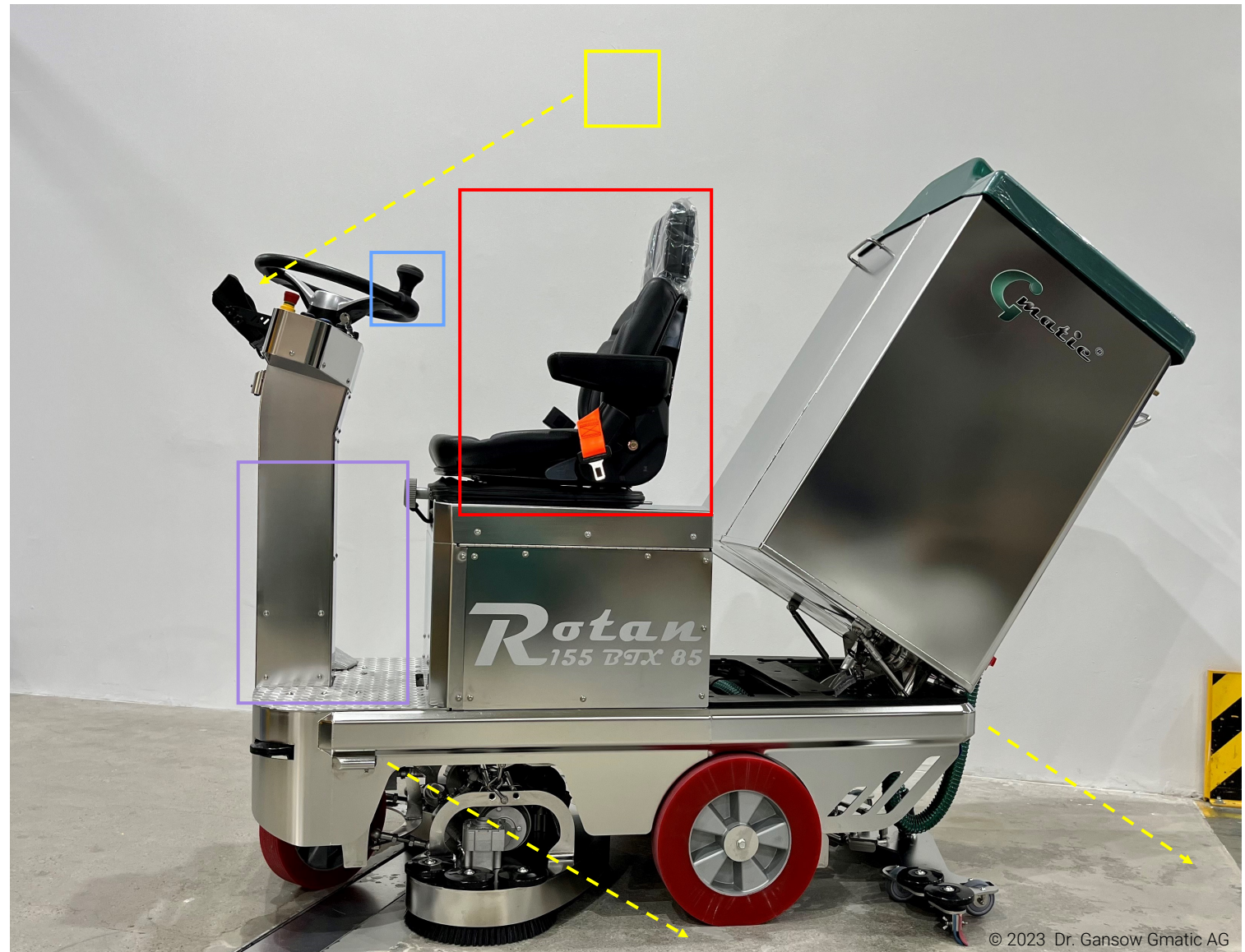
The ability to keep the body stable is important to compensate for shocks and vibrations while driving.

- The multi-adjustable comfort seat can be adapted to the individual body condition and thus protects against fatigue caused by poor posture
- The seat's spring package compensates for unwanted vibrations or poor floor con-

Leg mobility

Restricted leg mobility can affect the safe operation of a scrubber dryer. Gmatic offers...

- Individual positioning of the accelerator pedal
- individual construction and positioning of footrests in height and orientation
- One-pedal driving concept in which the speed is influenced and the active braking process is carried out using just one pedal.



Arm mobility

The ability to move the arms to different positions is important to reach and operate steering wheels, levers, switches and other controls on the machine.

- Steering knob to minimize hand overreach during steering maneuvers.
